CROQUET COMMITTEE CHARTER

Approved 1/16/11

Membership

The Croquet Committee shall consist of a minimum of three (3) Club members in good standing. The NCC Board shall appoint a Convener to identify members of this committee. The Committee Chair and the Committee Secretary are elected by the members of the Croquet Committee at its Organizational Meeting called by the Convener. Each of the committee members shall serve for one year and be eligible for reappointment up to a maximum of five consecutive terms in office. The Committee Chair shall designate one (1) member to act as liaison with the Social Committee.

Charge to the Croquet Committee

The Croquet Committee shall:

- advise the Board on all matters concerning croquet professionals and the scope of his or her operation,
- promulgate playing rules for members and their guests,
- program and oversee croquet events and activities for members and their guests.
- recommend special croquet events designed to maintain and improve the ability to attract and retain members in the Club.
- recommend and/or review any long-range plans for croquet events at the Club,
- advise on any croquet related purchases, hires or replacements of equipment, lawns or other facilities that directly impact the ability of members to play croquet at the Club.

Meetings

The Croquet Committee shall meet a minimum of four times per calendar year. Meeting dates and times are announced at least two weeks in advance by the Committee Secretary.

Governance

The Croquet Committee is accountable to the National Croquet Club Board of Directors.

The Social Committee shall act only as a committee and the individual members thereof shall have no power or authority. The chairman may appoint such subcommittees as he or she deems desirable from the members of the committee as a whole, which shall approve, amend or disapprove the report of the subcommittee
