## MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE CHARTER

Approved 01/08/11

### Membership

The Membership Committee shall consist of at least three (3) Club members in good standing. The NCC Board shall appoint a Convener to identify members of this committee. The Committee Chair and the Committee Secretary are elected by the members of the Membership Committee at its Organizational Meeting called by the Convener. Each of the committee members shall serve for one year and be eligible for reappointment up to a maximum of five consecutive terms in office. The Committee Chair shall designate one (1) member to act as liaison with the Social Committee and one (1) member to act as liaison with the Croquet Committee.

### Charge to the Membership Committee

The Membership Committee shall:

- recruit and retain members for the Club,
- Investigate all applications for membership and determine, in its sole discretion, approval or disapproval of each application. All approved applications shall be forwarded to the Board for its approval.
- Recommend policies that maintain and improve the ability to attract and retain members in the Club,
- Review and recommend a long-range membership development plan for the Club.
- Review the financial aspects of major proposed campaigns, new programs and services, as well as proposals to discontinue programs or services, and e

### Meetings

The Membership Committee meets at least four times per year. Meeting dates and times are announced at least two weeks in advance by the Committee Secretary.

### Governance

The Membership Committee is accountable to the National Croquet Club Board of Directors.

The Membership Committee shall act only as a committee and the individual members thereof shall have no power or authority. The chairman may appoint such subcommittees as he or she deems desirable from the members of the committee as a whole, which shall approve, amend or disapprove the report of the subcommittee.
